
Background

- China reportedly ready for export sales of their Type O52D Destroyer, likely with nomenclature O52DE or O52E*
- Ship class has seen upgrades since introduced in 2014
- Multiple purpose ships for variety of tasks
- 25 are known to exist in Chinese inventory with other hulls under construction
- No specific customers or costs yet mentioned
- Ship sales may help increase Chinese influence abroad*
