Background

- Recent March 2023 U.S. arms deal with Taiwan criticized by Chinese government in Chinese press and social media*
- Follows heightened tensions regarding Chinese balloon over U.S. air space, and U.S. pressure on China to not help arm Russia's efforts in Ukraine
- China condemned this recent arms deal as an affront to its sovereignty and security
- Seen by Chinese as violation of the one-China principle, undermining peace and stability in the Taiwan Strait*
