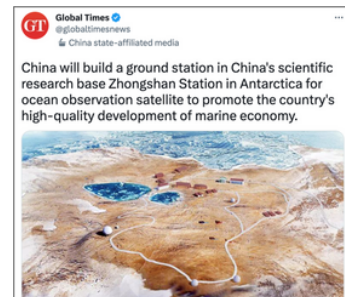
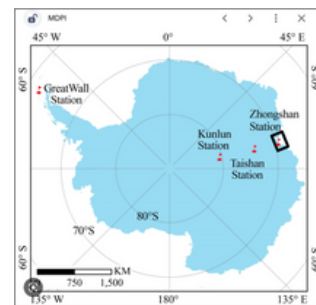
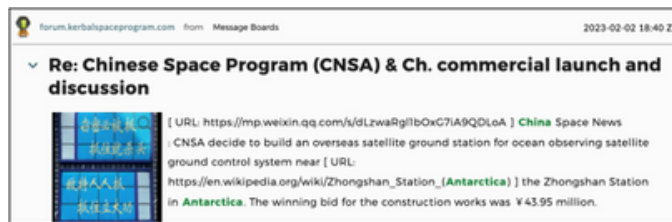
Open-Source Intelligence in Action

Background

- China will build overseas satellite ground stations in Antarctica to support satellite and space operations
- Stations will be another part of China's global network of ground stations, and will enhance ocean surveillance
- China Aerospace Science and Technology Group will build the stations*
