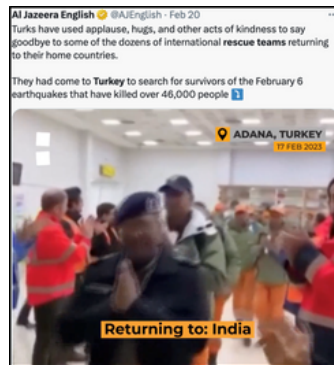
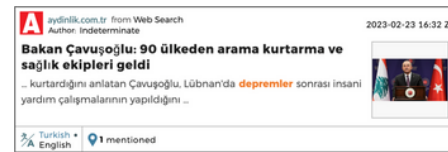
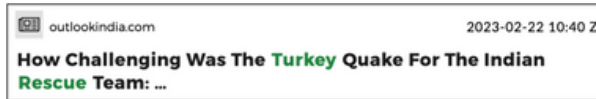

Background

- Earthquakes devastated Turkey and Syria early in 2023, along with thousands of aftershocks
- Turkey government criticized for unpreparedness, corruption, and insufficient/problematic responses
- Rescue and medical teams from 90 countries rallied to help and were impactful, as well as companies, NGOs, and tourists
- Foreign aid also included monetary donations, supplies, equipment
