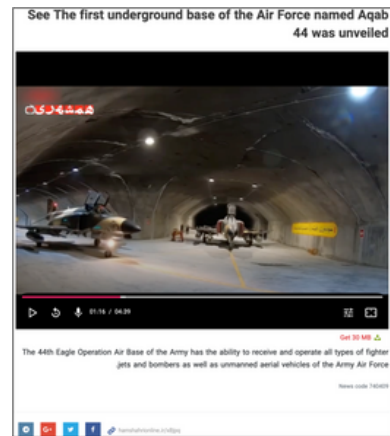
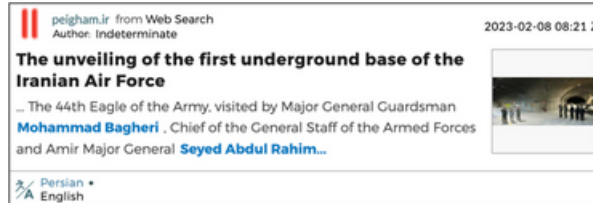
Open-Source Intelligence in Action

Background

- Iran reveals underground air base, one of “several” around the country
- Initially reported by Iranian press, operates fighters, bombers, and drones*
- Designated “Eagle 44,” aka “44th Eagle,” “Aqab 44,” or “Oghab 44”
- Allegedly less vulnerable to attack, and capable of “surprise” operations
- Base said to include alert and command post, maintenance hangars, equipment and fuel depot
- Locations not specified, but mountainous areas mentioned
