
Background*

- Zaporizhzhia Nuclear Power Plant (ZNPP) is 200 kilometers from the conflicted Donbas region
- Seized by Russian forces during the Battle of Energodar on March 4, 2022 (Russia/Ukraine)
- Conflicting reports from pro-Russian outlets and Ukrainian operator about power supply stability
- Continued to be serviced by Ukrainian personnel under the control of Russia after seizure
- As of May 10, 2023, Russian authorities to evacuate ZNPP staff (they were forced to remain in place prior to now)
