## The situation

Sophisticated technologies and ubiquitous data have enabled both interconnectedness and vulnerability around the world — and have given rise to a variety of threats by foreign powers intent on doing harm to other nations. Traditional threats to democracy or a nation’s critical infrastructure or supply chain are well known, but hybrid threats are not easily defined or detected and allow adversaries to take advantage of cyber ambiguity.
